• **NOTES FOR PLAYERS**

- **GAME FEES:** All Game Fees are to be pre-paid for the season after the initial Registration fee has been paid.
- **LATE ARRIVAL:** Rules applying to late arrival will apply until the Game Fee has been paid, i.e. 1 goal per minute, match claimed after 9 minutes. Penalty goals will be deducted from the offending team. In the event of a forfeit, the forfeit fee applies to the team responsible for the delay. In the event of unforeseen circumstances and a scratch match is offered, in the interest of good sportsmanship, a scratch match will be played and normal playing fees will apply to both teams.
- **SCORER:** The *second named* team must provide an official scorer. (Refer to By-Laws)
- The umpires are responsible for taking the completed score sheet to the Main Table at the conclusion of each match.
- **SUBSTITUTIONS / TEAM CHANGES:** Unlimited number of substitutions and up to 12 players on the Score Sheets. Team Managers are responsible for notifying Scorer and other team.
- **UNREGISTERED PLAYERS:** Penalty: 4 points
- **FILLING IN FOR A DIFFERENT TEAM:** Players may only play **UP** a total of twice in any higher section.
- **FORFEIT:** A team wishing to forfeit a match, is to notify the Secretary by 7pm on Monday evening or earlier if possible. The team must pay the forfeit fee of \$110.00. If a month's notice is given, a forfeit fee of \$55.00 applies for the 2009 Seasons.
The forfeit fee must be paid before the team's next scheduled game.
- **WALKOVER:** A team receiving a walkover can tick the players' names on the score sheet at the table or phone/email the names through to the Secretary within 24 hours of the scheduled time of the game.
A forfeit in the final series will mean exclusion for all the finals.
- **UNIFORM:** Positional bibs must be worn, 2 goal team penalty. Incorrect uniform after 3 weeks will incur a 2 goal penalty to the offending team for each breach of the rule.

- INJURIES: All injuries must be reported to the main table and an accident report form completed.
- NAILS AND JEWELLERY: Nails and all exposed body rings/studs to be taped with soft, flesh coloured tape only. No Band-aids. Regulation Netball Gloves may be worn. No hats/caps may be worn.
- TROPHIES: 10 trophies for Juniors and 9 Trophies for Open/Mixed Sections, will be awarded for qualified players participating in the Grand Final.
- All players, coaches and team managers should be familiar with the E.S.B.N.A.Inc By Laws, Council By-Laws, Notes for Players and Blood Procedure Policy.
